## Supervision

It is important to monitor your safe system of work to check it is working and being delivered correctly. For this reason, the Health and Safety at Work Act says you must provide suitable and sufficient supervision. This does not mean you must stand over people 100% of the time. A newly trained person may require close supervision at first, but as you gain confidence in their ability your level of supervision is likely to reduce. High risk activities might require closer supervision than those less hazardous activities.

To help you provide adequate and appropriate level of supervision for those conducting tasks, you might consider the following:

Good supervision can help you monitor the effectiveness of the training people have received, and whether people have the necessary capacity and competence to do the job.

Remember, once you are satisfied work is being conducted safely you can reduce the level of supervision. It is recommended you revisit and periodically supervise to measure the continued level of safety
